### GOLF

- **Ladies Greensomes**

There are still 10 tee times available for this event. Aileen has designed a promotional advert which will be shared on social media. Lesley agreed to share on the SWAT chat and the Scottish Ladies Golfing Group.

Aileen has added the event to Club V1. This will avoid any manual handicap calculations on the day. Lesley has offered to add the names and CDH numbers a week in advance (a sheet detailing this information will be provided by the Links). Aileen will then deal with any last minute cancellations & changes in the run up to the event.

Irene & Una will prepare cards and scoreboard in advance. On the day, couples will check in and receive their card detailing their combined handicap. Scores will be recorded on the card during the round, verified on completion then entered electronically into HDID. Aileen will provide a device for this purpose. Completed cards will then be handed in and a sample check made for accuracy.

Aileen will be around all day to oversee the smooth running of the event. Jan will attend after 12pm to assist. Ray & Carol will also help after their round. Aileen will also organise starters. Una will speak with Helen and Liz to ask if they will man the check in desk and run magic 2's and tombola.

Rachel volunteered herself and Jennifer to organise the tombola. Una volunteered to liaise with the pro's to obtain pin position flyers (to be given out with the cards at check in), nearest the pin prizes and a discounted clothing rail in the pro shop on the day.

- **Ladies Getting into Golf**

The programme is going well. Due to holidays etc, the ladies have been split into 2 groups. The first are out on the course on Tuesday evenings. The second will be with Gordon at the practice area until Tuesday 7 July. Aileen has decided to continue the on course sessions for an additional 4 weeks so the 2<sup>nd</sup> group have the chance to try out the Ashludie. Irene offered to gather details of helpers available to support the on course sessions from 7 July onwards.

Aileen confirmed that despite there now being a waiting list, if any of these ladies choose to join the Club the Links have agreed they can purchase a 7 day Links ticket.

## PROPERTY

- **Ladies Locker Room**

- **Honoraria**

Aileen updated us on the honoraria. The men's match secretary will have his Links fees paid. His helpers will each receive £100 towards their club fees. The ladies will receive £400 and it will be up to those who share the Match and Competition secretary roles to discuss and agree how this should be split.

- **HDID**

Aileen reiterated the importance of all ladies entering their own and their marker's score to prevent any discrepancies. If any issues occur, a picture of the card should be sent via WhatsApp to the Match Secretary Updates group.
